

Telemedicine Care in U.S. (2015)

In 2015, 15 million people received remote care via telemedicine out of 321 million total population.

Rise of Telemedicine Care in U.S. (2019)

32 million people received remote care via telemedicine out of 329 million total population, a total which is surging at an exceptional rate in Q1'2020 due to COVID-19.
